## Philippines Typhoon Mangkhut Appeal Helping communities recover and rebuild



As you may remember, just as the hurricane was hitting South Carolina in the USA a couple of weeks ago, people across the Philippines were hit by Typhoon Mangkhut, one of the strongest typhoons to hit the islands since 2013.

Known locally as Ompong, the typhoon has caused a huge amount of destruction, and even though many communities were prepared for the storm to arrive, there was little they could do to stop the landslides and flash floods that exacerbated the damage caused by the initial typhoon.

Christian Aid is particularly concerned for those communities in more remote mountainous areas who are extremely vulnerable. In many areas, people's harvest was days away from being ready but has now been completely lost. This comes at a time of high inflation in their economy, and so now there are longer-term concerns around food security.

We are supporting the **Typhoon Mangkhut Appeal** this harvest, so that from our excess we can help those who have lost their harvest. So please donate what you can so we can help communities rebuild and recover.

Here are some ideas of what our giving can do:

£14 could buy one food kit or one hygiene kit, containing items like soap and toothpaste, for one family for two weeks.

£22 could buy one essential kit, containing items like kitchenware, blankets and flashlights.

£70 could buy a temporary shelter kit for one family.
